Application Period Now Open for the Louisiana Legislative Women's Caucus Foundation Educational Advancement Opportunity (EAO) Scholarship

Baton Rouge, Louisiana –The Louisiana Legislative Women's Caucus Foundation today announced the opening of the application period for the LLWCF Educational Advancement Opportunity (EAO) Scholarship. This newly created scholarship is the brainchild of the women of the Louisiana Legislature, who are determined to broaden the educational opportunities available to young women in Louisiana. Each scholarship is for \$500 and will be used to defray the costs of tuition, room and board and/or books. Multiple scholarships will be awarded.

Scholarships can be applied to a licensed proprietary school, theological or seminary school, two-year technical or community college, four-year college or university or a graduate or professional school. Recipients must attend school in the Fall of 2011.
