In addition, the Foundation will give educational scholarships during the awards' program to deserving young women. Since 2010, the women legislators in Louisiana have awarded \$25,000 in scholarships to deserving young women in our great state. Scholarships to be awarded include:

- The Louisiana Legislative Women's Caucus Foundation Scholarship for \$1,000 which will be awarded to the winners of the High School Woman of Excellence Award and the College Woman of Excellence Award
- Several Educational Advancement Opportunity (EAO) Scholarships for \$500. Individuals can apply for the EAO Scholarship, if they **are not** applying for the High School Woman of Excellence Award or the College Woman of Excellence Award.

	<p>Women of Excellence nominees are role models, leaders and innovators who embody the extraordinary characteristics of being hardworking, inspirational to others and entrepreneurial and who personify excellence in integrity and service to others.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. <b>Business</b> – A woman business owner or a woman who has excelled in business and/or business operations as an entrepreneur or in management.</li><li>2. <b>College Woman of Excellence (ages 18 to 25)</b> – A young woman who personifies excellence in integrity, character, academics, leadership and community service and who is within the age range of 18 to 25. The nominee must have a grade point average of 3.0 and be currently enrolled in a two-year technical or community college, four-year college/university or a graduate/professional school. (Other criteria apply.)</li><li>3. <b>Health &amp; Medicine</b> – A woman who has excelled in the area of health and/or medicine, which has resulted in the betterment of individual lives, communities and/or has resulted in the development of significant policies, initiatives and innovations in medicine and/or health.</li><li>4. <b>High School Woman of Excellence (must be a graduating senior)</b> – A young woman who personifies excellence in integrity, character, academics, leadership and community service. The nominee must have a grade point average of 3.0, be a graduating senior from a Louisiana high school or approved home school program, graduating in the class of 2014 and be a resident of Louisiana. (Other criteria apply.)</li><li>5. <b>Louisiana Hero of Excellence</b> – A woman who is an ordinary everyday person, who is making extraordinarily positive differences in changing the lives of people in Louisiana and/or beyond.</li><li>6. <b>Non-Profit of Excellence</b> – An IRS recognized non-profit in good standing, which works to improve or strengthen the lives of women and/or girls in Louisiana.</li></ol>

**Note: The recipient of the College Woman of Excellence Award will also receive a Louisiana Legislative Women's Caucus Foundation Scholarship for \$1,000 made payable to the recipient's college/university (restrictions apply).**

**I. Criteria of Eligibility:**

1. Must be a young woman between the ages of 18 and 25 and a resident of Louisiana.
2. Must be currently enrolled in a two-year technical or community college, four-year college/university or a graduate/professional school.
3. Must have attended school in Fall 2014 and will attend school in Spring 2015 and in Fall 2015.
4. Must have a grade point average of at least a 3.0 or better.
5. Must show attributes of excellence in academics, leadership, community service/volunteerism, integrity and character.
6. Self-Nominations **will not be** accepted.

**II. Deadline:**

All applications and documents must be uploaded electronically online by **Friday, February 6, 2015**. **All incomplete packets will be automatically disqualified.**

**III. Application Requirements – A completed application must include the following:**

1. **Nomination Character Reference Form and Letter** – Individuals must be nominated for this award. The nominator (the person who will nominate the college student) must complete and submit online the nomination form, which includes a character reference form and a character reference letter about the nominee. The form and the letter must be signed by the nominator and submitted electronically online. The nomination and character reference form is available at: <http://jotformpro.com/form/43103238649959>. The deadline for the form to be completed and submitted online is Friday, February 6, 2015.
2. **Application** – Nominee must complete the College Woman of Excellence Application and submit the required information online. The application can be completed online at: <http://jotformpro.com/form/43106181783958>.
3. **Essay** – Please respond with an essay on the following: "According to Centers for Disease Control (CDC), approximately one in five young undergraduate women have been the victim of attempted or completed sexual violence in college. What do you think should be done on college campuses to ensure the safety of young women?" Your essay is not to exceed 500 words. The essay will be judged and given serious consideration.
4. **Letter of Recommendation Form and Letter** – Must come from a teacher, instructor or professor who has had the opportunity to evaluate you as a student. Both the recommendation form and letter must be signed and dated by the person giving the recommendation. These documents must be completed and submitted electronically online at <http://jotformpro.com/form/43104071000936>. Please send the link to the person, who will be responsible for submitting your recommendation form and letter. The deadline for the form to be completed and submitted online is Friday, February 6, 2015.
5. **Transcript** – An official transcript must be uploaded online with your un-weighted grade point average, which includes your Fall 2014 grades. Applications will be disqualified if the un-weighted grade point average is not included.
6. **Proof of Registration** – Must submit proof of registration from a two-year technical or community college, a four-year college/university or a graduate/professional school for Spring 2015.
7. **Agreement and Consent Form** – This form is to be signed electronically by the applicant and her parent/guardian (if the applicant is under the age of 18 years old) and acknowledges all information is true and accurate in the application.

**IV. College Woman of Excellence Award Recognition:**

1. The recipient will be recognized at the 2015 Louisiana Legislative Women's Caucus Foundation's Women of Excellence Awards & Scholarship Ceremony and Reception Tuesday, May 26, 2015 at a time and location to be announced.
2. The recipient must attend the awards ceremony in person.
3. The recipient of the College Woman of Excellence Award will also receive a Louisiana Legislative Women's Caucus Foundation Scholarship for \$1,000 made payable to the recipient's college/university. The scholarship check will be sent directly to the university/college to which the recipient attends by June 26, 2015.

**VI. Procedural Guidelines:**

1. The LLWCF's Women of Excellence Award Nomination and Character Reference Form, the Women of Excellence Application Form and all attachments will be the determining factors for the Women of Excellence Awards.
2. Upon receipt, nomination data and all pertinent information become the property of Women's Caucus and will not be returned.
3. The awards' committee reserves the right to move a nominee to a more appropriate category and to withhold an award in any category.
4. Nominations sent via fax or email will not be accepted.
5. Previous award and scholarship recipients of the Louisiana Legislative Women's Caucus Foundation Scholarship are not eligible to apply.
6. Current members of the Louisiana Legislative Women's Caucus, its staff and immediate members of their families are not eligible for the award.
7. Incomplete packages and those missing information will be disqualified.
8. Unsigned forms, letters and agreement and consent forms will not be accepted.
9. The foundation reserves the right to discontinue any category should an inadequate number of candidates apply or suitable candidates are not nominated.
10. All applicants will be notified via email regarding the final outcome of the selection process.

**VI. Procedural Guidelines (continued):**

11. After recipients are selected, they will be required to submit the following documents:
- a. One Page Biography -- A one-page, double-spaced biography in Microsoft Word format in paragraph form, which will be used in our program book. When requested, this document must be submitted via email to [llwc@legis.la.gov](mailto:llwc@legis.la.gov) by **Friday, April 10, 2015**.
  - b. Short Paragraph Biography – A one paragraph biography in Microsoft Word format in paragraph form. This will be used in the video presentation. Include the name of your parents/ guardians, major, career goals, special interests and other scholastic honors, achievements and distinctions received. When requested, this document must be submitted via email to [llwc@legis.la.gov](mailto:llwc@legis.la.gov) by **Friday, April 10, 2015**.
  - c. Photograph – An electronic high-resolution photo of yourself (at least 300 dpi in either TIF or JPG format as a separate file). NOTE: "Selfie" photographs WILL NOT be accepted. Please do not embed your photo onto your biography. Please do not send any photocopies or photographs with other persons in the picture. When requested, this document must be submitted via email to [llwc@legis.la.gov](mailto:llwc@legis.la.gov) by **Friday, April 10, 2015**.
  - d. Proof of Registration – Must submit proof of registration from a two-year technical or community college or a four-year college/university for Fall 2015. This must be submitted to the Women's Caucus Office by June 5, 2015. This will be required before any scholarship checks are disbursed. When requested, this document must be submitted via fax to 225.377.2261 or email to [llwc@legis.la.gov](mailto:llwc@legis.la.gov) by the specified deadline.

**VII. Completed Packets Must be Received by Friday, February 6, 2015:**

Applications must be completed online and electronically submitted to the Louisiana Legislative Women's Caucus Foundation via the provided website by **Friday, February 6, 2015**. Mailed packets will not be accepted. All incomplete packets will be automatically disqualified.
